



United Soccer League of Pennsylvania COVID 19 Protocol & Contact Tracing 2020-2021 Season

The United Soccer League of PA will utilize the guidelines as provided by our Governing Bodies - EPSA and USASA -- as well as those as prescribed by the Governor of Pennsylvania and the CDC. These documents will be linked to our website for reference. The guidelines are not intended to be all encompassing as teams may feel the need to institute stricter guidelines for their teams, however it is imperative that for the safety of all players that these guidelines are followed.

- If a player, coach, referee or spectator feels ill, do not attend any United League sporting event -- training or game.
- Teams are to keep attendance of all players and staff at each session -- training session, scrimmage or official League match -- if needed for future reference “contact tracing”
- Any field specific COVID-19 Protocols should be shared with the league and opponents prior to the beginning of the season.
- If any player, coach or referee test positive for COVID-19, you must reach out to Michelle Paul michellepaul5293@hotmail.com immediately for tracking purposes and to ensure containment within the league. Your information will be kept confidential. We encourage players to take their temperatures prior to the match to ensure that they are not sick before attending an USL event.

Plan of Action

- In the event that a player, coach, or referee tests positive for COVID-19, they have an obligation to report such instances to the league. Appropriate contact tracing will allow us to inform the league participants of any possible exposure to COVID-19.
- All active members will be notified if a member has tested positive in the league.
- In the event of game or season cancellations, the Board of Directors will make all decisions in regards to allocation of registration fees.
- All players, coaches, staff and spectators are subject to the rules and policies of the facilities to be used.
